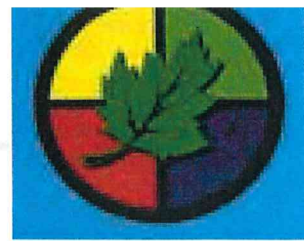
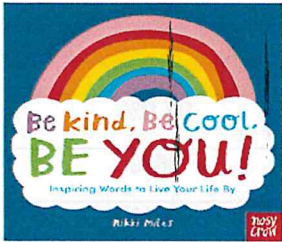

Welcome back!

I hope you all had a great half-term break. School has got off to a busy start with Y4 completing their multiplication test. We are so proud of the children's attitudes towards learning their times tables and we are very grateful for the support they have received at home. Next week, Y1 will complete their phonics screening check and Y2 will do their SATS. Please ensure that your children are in school every day next week!

Miss Tierney has already informed you of the changes to government legislation regarding holidays during term time. Please can I make everyone aware that these changes have not come from school but are direct from the government and ALL schools have to follow them. Changes from September 2024 are as follows:

- From September 2024, if you take your child out of school for a holiday for 5 school days or more, you will receive a penalty notice. (Previously 10 school days)
 - Penalty notice charges will increase to £80 per parent per child, (Previously £60)
 - If you take your child out of school for a second time within a 3 school year period the penalty notice charge will be £160 per parent per child.
 - A 3rd holiday within 3 school years will go straight to prosecution and could result in a criminal record.
 - If your child is consistently late and receives a 'U' mark, 10 times within a 10 school week period, You could also be eligible for a fixed penalty notice.
- Your child will receive a 'U' mark if they arrive at school past 9.30am

I do appreciate that this new guidance may be frustrating but ALL schools need to follow it to ensure a consistent approach to attendance.
