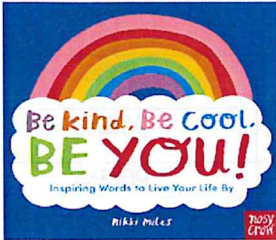

It's been another busy week in school, with lots of lovely opportunities for our children.

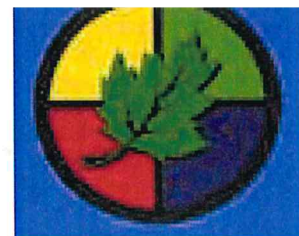
Year 5 Art Workshop
